 - O Must meet in person
 - O Establish connection/chemistry

International Marriage Broker Regulation Act

- US government passed in 2005 with VAWA
- O Based on narrative of abusive men
 - O High profile murder cases
 - O Predators
- Restrictions
 - Meet in Person
 - O 2 K1 fiancé visas per lifetime
 - Background checks

Marriage Process

- Fraudulent marriages occur very rarely
- Numerous years to citizenship and green card
- O Citizenship interviews are set up to help determine
- Once again, must meet in person
